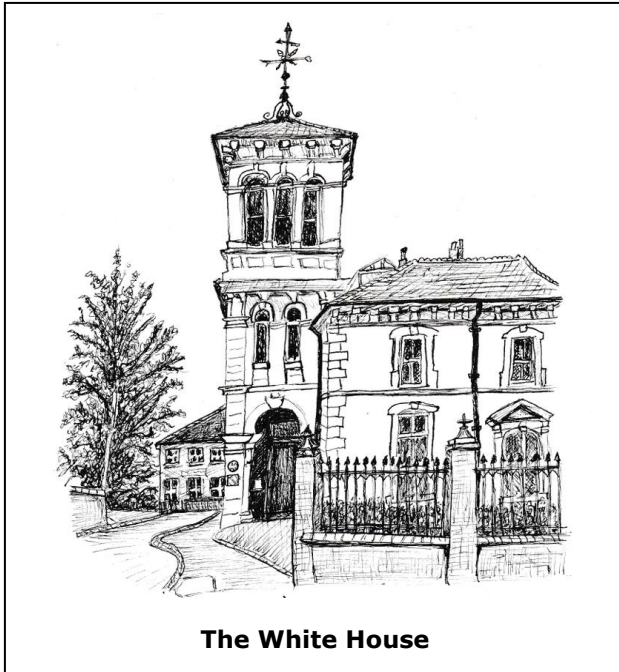

PHARMACIES

Pharmacies – can provide advice and information on many health concerns e.g. pain relief/self-medication/use of prescription medicines/some diagnostic tests/medical conditions and aids.

Private consultation rooms are usually available. Ask your Pharmacy/GP Surgery about Repeat/Batch Prescriptions, Electronic Prescription Services and the delivery of medicines.

Pharmacy First - This service enables community pharmacists to supply prescription-only medicines, including antibiotics and antivirals where clinically appropriate, to treat seven common health conditions without the need to visit a GP. A record of the consultation will be made and shared with your GP. The conditions are, **sinusitis, sore throat, earache, infected insect bite, impetigo, shingles, uncomplicated urinary tract infections in women (aged 16-64).**

Please note that pharmacies do not allow medication to be dispensed when the pharmacist is on a lunch break or not on the premises.

Charter Markets – Every Tuesday and Saturday with a Farmers Market on third Saturday and Craft Market on fourth Saturday of the month.

Parks and Open Spaces – Green flag parks include Parson’s Close Recreation Ground, Pages Park, Linslade Recreation Ground, Linslade Memorial Playing Field and Garden of Remembrance and Vandyke Cemetery. Other LLTC managed parks and green spaces include Astral Park, Pages Field, Ousel Valley Meadows and Peace Meadow, Linslade.

Other nearby open spaces include Rushmere and Stockgrove Country Parks run by the Greensand Trust and Bluebell Wood – Linslade, Tiddenfoot Waterside Park and Stanbridge Meadows, managed by CBC.

Public Conveniences – at West Street car park, Parson’s Close Rec (summer only), local supermarkets (Tesco and Morrisons) and in most premises serving food.

Sports and Exercise Facilities – the town parks include Green Gym equipment and free to use tennis court, basketball court and table tennis tables.

Parking – Town car parks are managed by Central Bedfordshire Council and include Duncombe Drive, Hockliffe Street, West Street multi-storey and Baker Street. Parking is also available on the High Street and in Church Square. Restrictions apply, check signage. Disabled parking spaces are available in West Street multi-storey car park. CBC operates a cashless system for all council run car parks.

Two important town events run by voluntary committees are the **May Fayre** and the **Carnival**. The May Fayre is organised by Leighton Linslade Rotary Club – contact Alan 01525 754820 www.leightonlinsladerotary.com . The Carnival is held in July – contact Mark 07930 152026 www.leightoncarnival.co.uk if you wish to help or take part. Both events fundraise to support local charitable groups and services.
